

**Minutes [NonPublic]**  
Albany NH Selectmen's Meeting  
September 15, 2010

**NonPublic Session:**

At 4:14 p.m. Joe made a motion to move into nonpublic session citing RSA 91-A:3 II (a). Jack seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Joe noted he had signed a check a few weeks ago that he was not in agreement with. Joe feels that the taxpayer's money should not be spent on conference overnight stays at the Red Jacket. Sara suggested creating a policy that overnight stays be paid for after a set distance has been surpassed. Jack said the overnight stay is not a major expense. Joe replied it is the taxpayer's money. Joe suggested paying the cost of transportation instead, such as a taxi. Jack asked if the policy would include the taxi fee and a minimum mileage. Sara suggested a minimum of 20 miles before the town pays for an overnight stay. Joe made a motion to set a policy for the town to pay for conference overnight stays after a minimum of 20 miles has been travelled. Sara seconded the motion and all were in favor.

At 4:25 p.m., Joe motioned to move into public session, seconded by Jack and all were in favor.
