Albany NH Selectmen's Meeting

October 28, 2009

At 4:00 p.m. the Selectmen's meeting was called to order. In attendance were Dan Sdankus and Sara Young-Knox. Also present were Rob Nadler and Executive Director of the North Country Council Michael King. The following business was conducted.

Michael King:

Michael introduced himself to the Board and then detailed what North Country Council does. They currently are assisting Albany to update the All-Hazard Mitigation Program. They also are involved with NHDOT projects throughout the 51 communities they serve. They create safe school routes by provided sidewalks and signs if necessary. North Country Council is also involved in advising of economic development. They provide limited technical assistance to Planning Boards and provide training sessions to Planning Boards.

Rob Nadler told the Board of Selectmen that a letter of intent must be sent to the North Country Council in order to take part in the Scenic By-Ways grant. Michael told Rob, yes that is true and it is due by November 15. He was not sure of when the program will start or how much money would be available but now was the time to send the letter of intent. Michael told the Board that currently Bartlett, Conway, Madison and Eaton do not belong to the North Country Council. Rob thought they if they did belong the Mount Washington Valley would have a greater voice when it comes to state projects in our area.

At 4:45 p.m., Dan made a motion to adjourn, Sara Young-Knox seconded the motion and all were in favor.
