Description of matters discussed and final decisions made: _ Steve Parker evicted Daniel Sargent from 147 Golden Oaks. The mobile home has been boarded up and Steve would like to demolish it. He is asking that the back taxes be abated so the trailer is free and clear. Rick asked how many trailers are not correctly deeded. Steve will look into it but said most are now deeded correctly. After a sale, he takes the new deed to the Registry of Deeds himself. Steve said the residents of Piper Meadows need to be educated as to the Town's ability to tax deed their mobile homes. They have nowhere else to live, they will come in to pay if the consequence is there. Steve added there is one more mobile home that needs to be demolished and owes back taxes. The prior owner passed away last fall. Steve is not ready to demolish that trailer yet. Rick would like to tour Piper Meadows on May 2 and have the Health Officer present. Steve verbally granted permission for the Selectmen and Health Officer to tour the property. He will submit a letter in writing as well. Rick made a motion to abate \$1922.58 on taxes owed on 147 Golden Oaks, Joe seconded the motion. Rick and Cathy were in favor of the motion, Joe abstained.
