CAMPING/CAMPFIRE ORDINANCE- ALBANY, NH

Pursuant to NH RSA 41:11-a, no overnight camping or fires are allowed on town property. Violators are subject to a \$250.00 fine

No camping, camp sites or camp fires: allowed within ¼ miles (1320 feet) of Passaconaway Road and on all roads in or adjacent to the U.S. National Forest or other public lands in the Town of Albany. For the purpose of this ordinance, sleeping in a vehicle is considered camping. Measurement is taken from the edge of the pavement on the side of the road that the camp site is located.

This section of fines and penalties is granted by RSA: 41:11-b

If payment of fines is not received within five (5) business days after the date of the ticket, the Carroll County Sheriff's Department will follow through with a letter to the violator advising that a court summons will be issued if the fine remains unpaid.

This amended ordinance shall take effect on June 20, 2018, per order of the Albany, Board of Selectmen.
