

## Town of Albany, NH Planning Board Monthly Meeting March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Call to Order: 6:39 pm

Attendance: Sean Wadsworth (Chair), Curtis Coleman, Bryan Bailey, Morris West (Alternate)

Sean Wadsworth appointed Morris West as a voting member.

Morris West made a motion to approve the January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 minutes. Bryan Bailey seconded. The motion carried 4-0-0

### New Business:

Preliminary Consultation – Map 7 Lot 115 – Tin Mountain Conservation Center (TMCC).

Rick Van De Poll, the research director for Tin Mountain Conservation Center presented an overview of TMCC's plans to construct a 28ft x 40ft outdoor classroom Pavilion that will be a timber frame structure with a metal roof, and no walls. This structure would sit atop a graded gravel surface, with posts anchored to sono tubes. There will be no power, no water, and no septic system at this location. The primary use will be for school groups to have shelter.

Sean Wadsworth stated that the Town of Albany Zoning Ordinances would permit this type of use, subject to Site Plan Review.

The Planning Board advised Mr. Van De Poll that Site Plan Review would be required for the proposed Pavilion. Following this the APB read through the SPR regulations with Mr. Van De Poll identifying the sections that may be waived given the scale and scope of the proposed development.
