



## Albany 29597 Public Informational Meeting

*NHDOT will solicit community input to review potential safety improvements and prioritize improvement locations along NH Route 16 in Albany*

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) will hold a Public Informational Meeting to discuss potential corridor improvements to NH Route 16 in Albany and Madison. The original New Hampshire Ten-Year Plan application requested to address safety and identified higher crash rates and lower-cost rumble strip counter measures. This is the second planned public meeting focusing on potential alternative locations and soliciting public input at the event to ensure that project decisions meet public transportation needs and community goals, as well as protect and enhance the environment.

The meeting is scheduled for **June 12, 2024 at 5:30PM**, following the regularly scheduled Selectboard meeting at Albany Town Hall, 1972A NH Route 16, Albany. The informational meeting offers the public an opportunity to learn about the solutions proposed, to ask questions, and provide their thoughts to prioritize where improvements should be implemented. The agenda for this includes:

- 5:30 PM, Doors will open for informal viewing of presentation materials
- 6:00 PM, Introductory presentation
- 6:15-7:30 PM, Rotating workshop to review potential alternatives along NH 16
- 7:30-8:00 PM, Closing presentation and Question & Answer Session

An environmental review of the project's potential impacts on natural and cultural resources is underway in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act. This project may have an effect on cultural or historic resources that are potentially eligible for or listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Individuals or organizations with a demonstrated interest in the potential impacts to historic resources have an opportunity to become Consulting Parties under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Additional information will be provided at the public informational meeting.
