-PUBLIC NOTICE-

In accordance with RSA 4:30-a, notice is hereby provided that the proposed projects to improve the safety of the NH Route 16 corridor and address the existing roadway conditions in the Towns of Albany and Madison will require the acquisition of municipal land that is used for conservation or recreation. After careful evaluation of the alternatives, this project will need to acquire municipal property interests as described below:

Albany-Madison Project #29597, X-A004(190)

The purpose of the Albany-Madison projects is to improve the safety of the NH Route 16 corridor and address the existing roadway conditions in the Towns of Albany and Madison. The proposed improvements address the safety and pavement conditions of NH Route 16 beginning approximately 2.0 miles north of the Tamworth Townline (Mile Marker 70.8) and ending approximately 0.8 miles north of the Madison Townline (Mile Marker 73.6). The recommended alternative includes roadway reconstruction and shoulder widening. intersection improvements, and addition of auxiliary lanes, NH Route 16 geometric improvements, bridge rehabilitation, as well as incidental roadway construction required to improve safety by addressing lane departure and intersection crashes occurring in this segment.

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The proposed NH Route 16 reconstruction proposes improvements at the intersection of NH Route 16 and Town Hall Road, requiring acquisition of right-of-way and easements for permanent maintenance and temporary construction easements.

A public hearing will be held on this project as required for approval to lay out the proposed highway. This hearing will be held no sooner than ninety (90) days from the date of this Notice. An additional public notice will be given stating the specific date, time, and location of the hearing.
