4. <u>APPOINTMENT</u> – Road Agent C. Coleman to discuss Engine Brake Restrictions and agreement with Town of Sandwich in regard to plowing Ferncroft Rd.

The BOS and the Road Agent discussed implementing the unnecessary use of Engine Brakes as outlined in the Albany Noise Ordinance. As defined in Article B. of the Albany Town Noise Ordinance.

b. Misuse of braking power exceeding tire traction limits in deceleration where there is no emergency.

The Bos and Road Agent discussed signage, placement and enforcement by the Carroll County Sheriff's Department.
